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CHILDREN'S CATECHISM QUESTIONS

84. Q. What is the first commandment? A. The first commandment is “You shall have no other gods before Me.” (NKJV)
85. Q. What does the first commandment teach you? A. To worship the true God, and him only.
86. Q. What is the second commandment? A. The second commandment is “You shall not make for yourself a carved image.. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.” (NKJV)
87. Q. What does the second commandment teach you? A. To worship God only as he commands, and not to worship God by using statues or pictures.

WEEK 1

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CHILDREN'S CATECHISM QUESTIONS

90. Q. What is the fourth commandment? A. The fourth commandment is “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God. In it you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who is within your gates. For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.” (NKJV)
91. Q. What does the fourth commandment teach you? A. To work six days and keep the Sabbath day holy.
92. Q. What day of the week is the Christian Sabbath? A. The first day of the week, called the Lord’s Day.
93. Q. Why is it called the Lord’s Day? A. Because on that day the Lord Jesus Christ rose from the dead.
94. Q. How should you keep the Lord’s Day? A. I should rest from my daily work and faithfully worship God

Romans 3:19-26

- 19 Now we know that whatever the law says it speaks to those who are under the law, so that every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God.
- 20 For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin.
- 21 But now the righteousness of God has been manifested apart from the law, although the Law and the Prophets bear witness to it—
- 22 the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all who believe. For there is no distinction:
- 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- 24 and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,
- 25 whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins.
- 26 It was to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

100. Q. What does the seventh commandment teach you? A. To be pure in heart, language and conduct, and to be faithful in marriage.
