Topic #2: Praying like a Child

Question: What does the doctrine of Sonship or Adoption mean?
The Problem Defined: We know what Sonship is, we believe it, but we don't experience it.
Questions: What is a child like?
<u>Prayer is Childlike:</u> Children are Selfish, their attention spans are scattered, they ask in an uninhibited way, they pester, they act like their true selves.
<u>Prayer is Relational:</u> We don't use different language. We don't pray just for prayers sake, but we pray to engage with God.
Question: How can our prayers be more relational and childlike?
